**National Weather Service issues Flood**  
**Watch from 2PM today until 2 PM Friday**

**COUNTYWIDE:**

Bergen County OEM is continuing to monitor a rain event that is expected to affect our area with heavy thunderstorms, beginning this afternoon through Friday afternoon. Current forecasts estimate 1 -2 inches of rain, with locally higher amounts possible. The heaviest rain will be late this afternoon through midnight.

Runoff may result in minor to moderate flash flooding of rivers, small creeks, streams, and other low lying and flood prone locations. Urban flooding of low lying and poor drainage areas is likely.

We will continue to monitor this situation and issue updates as necessary.

**HACKENSACK RIVER WATERSHED AREA:**

Bergen County officials have been in contact with Veolia Water company representatives:

- Woodcliff Lake and Tappan Dams are likely going to spill
- Oradell dam is currently 5ft below spill level

Officials should monitor the waterways in their communities and take action if necessary. Please be sure to take appropriate mitigation actions to protect flood prone properties.
