Agreement: The application, signed by the applicant under his or her oath, shall state: (1) the applicant's name and address; (2) the applicant's age, if the applicant is less than 18 years of age; (3) the political party to which he or she belongs or, if the applicant is not affiliated with a political party, the fact that the applicant is not so affiliated; (4) that the applicant is of good moral character and has not been convicted of any crime involving moral turpitude; and (5) that the applicant possesses the following qualifications: eyesight, with or without correction, sufficient to read nonpareil type; ability to read the English language readily; ability to add and subtract figures correctly; ability to write legibly with reasonable facility; reasonable knowledge of the duties to be performed by the applicant as an election officer under the election laws of this State; and health sufficient to discharge his or her duties as an election officer. N.J.S.A 19-6-2b In the event of my appointment to the District Board of Elections, the statutory pay for working on Election Day is \$300(N.J. Stat. § 19:45-6.2). I can be removed, replaced or not rehired with or without cause (N.J.S.A 19:6-5). I swear that the above statements are true to the best of my knowledge and belief.
